

CONDITIONS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE WORLD HERITAGE VOLUNTEER PROGRAM IN SAN MILLÁN DE LA COGOLLA. 2024 campaign. A Benedictine landscape.

Dates. Volunteers arrive on July 15. Volunteers depart on July 28. Accepted individuals must participate in the project from the start date, July 15, until the end date. No arrivals will be accepted after the start date or departures before the end date.

Transfers. Volunteers will cover the transportation costs from their city of origin to San Millán de la Cogolla. The Foundation will not cover any transportation costs but will provide all necessary information for participants to arrive using public transportation.

Accommodation. Volunteers will be housed in a rural hotel in the town center, close to the work site. Volunteers will sleep in double rooms and will share bathrooms. The San Millán Foundation will cover accommodation expenses. Accommodation is exclusively for participants' use; family and friends of participants are not allowed to use the accommodation.

Living together. Participants agree to respect basic rules of coexistence: cleanliness, hygiene, rest schedules, and respect for privacy.

Meals. Breakfast will be provided at the accommodation. Lunch will be served at the accommodation (self-service), and dinner will be at restaurants in the town. Volunteers must indicate before arrival if they have any dietary restrictions for health, religious, or other reasons to adjust the menus. The San Millán Foundation will cover the costs of breakfast, lunch, and dinner during volunteers' stay.

Insurance. Volunteers must have travel insurance, health insurance, or a European Health Insurance Card. The San Millán Foundation will not cover volunteers' insurance costs. The Foundation will assume liability insurance during the project.

Health services. San Millán de la Cogolla has medical service and a pharmacy. All medical expenses incurred will be covered by the volunteer through their insurance. The San Millán Foundation will not cover these expenses.

Work schedule. The work schedule will be from 9:00 am to 5:30 pm. There will be a lunch break at 1:30 pm. In the afternoon, various activities will be scheduled starting at 5:30 pm. Dinner will be at 9:00 pm. This schedule may change, but volunteers will be duly informed.

Work development. Volunteers commit to following the technical instructions provided by the San Millán de la Cogolla Foundation team and to respecting the facilities of the work space.

Language. Work will be conducted primarily in Spanish as there is interaction with the local community, and secondarily in English.

Intellectual property. Participants agree not to use the results of the work done during the volunteer program without prior communication and authorization from the San Millán Foundation team and other collaborating institutions of the project.

Participation certificate. Upon completion of the volunteer program, all participants will receive a certificate of attendance.
